Notice of Proposed Amendment To ASCD Constitution

In accordance with Article VII of the ASCD Constitution, the Executive Committee of the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, NEA, proposes the following amendment to the ASCD Constitution.

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for disposition of any assets or funds of the Association in the event of its dissolution as an organization.

Ballots will be sent to ASCD members on or before April 1, with the request that ballots be returned to ASCD headquarters by May 1. The amendment hereby proposed by the ASCD Executive Committee would add a new article to the Constitution.

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE IX— ASSETS ON LIQUIDATION

No part of the net income, revenue and grants of the Association shall inure to the benefit of any member, officer or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered in connection with one or more of its purposes), and no member, officer or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the assets of the Association, on its dissolution or liquidation. In the event of such dissolution or liquidation, the assets of the Association, after payment of debts and obligations, shall be transferred to the National Education Association of the United States for its charitable and educational purposes, provided the said National Education Association is then exempt from federal income taxes as a charitable and/or educational organization. If the said National Education Association is not then so exempt the net assets, as aforesaid, shall be transferred to an organization with federal tax exemption for charitable and educational uses and purposes similar to those of this Association, which exempt organization shall be designated by the final Executive Committee of the Association.
