Notice of Proposed Amendment To ASCD Constitution

In accordance with Article VIII of the ASCD Constitution, the Executive Committee of the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, NEA, proposes the following amendment to the By-Laws of the ASCD Constitution.

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an omission in the Constitution.

Ballots will be sent to ASCD members on or before March 15, with the request that ballots be returned to ASCD headquarters by April 15. The amendment hereby proposed by the ASCD Executive Committee would alter the By-Laws of the Constitution as indicated below.

CONSTITUTION

By-Laws

ARTICLE VIII—AFFILIATION

Presently Reads (Italics, matter to be deleted)

State groups requesting affiliation must meet the following requirements: (1) a state group applying for affiliation must have an ongoing organization; and (2) the purpose and policies, including the policy of unrestricted membership, of any state group applying for affiliation, must be *identical* with those of the national organization. The Executive Committee shall act on application for affiliation from all state groups.

Proposed New Reading (Bold type, matter to be added)

State groups requesting affiliation must meet the following requirements: (1) a state group applying for affiliation must have an ongoing organizaion; and (2) the purpose and policies, including the policy of unrestricted membership, of any state group applying for affiliation, must be consistent with those of the national organization. The Executive Committee shall act on application for affiliation from all state groups. Any state group which does not maintain the membership policy of the Association or is in violation of any provision of the Constitution may be disaffiliated by action of the Executive Committee, approved by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors.
