

Across the United States...

- > 9% of teenagers are not in school and not working
- > 33% of kids live in families where no parent works full time year round
- > 22% of kids live in poverty
- > 10% live in extreme poverty (<50% of poverty income)
- > 32% are obese
- ➤ 10% of children under age 17 do not have health insurance








Each student enters school healthy and learns and practices a healthy lifestyle.

Each student is actively engaged in learning and is connected to the school and broader community.


Each student

Unchallenged






3. The "rigor above all else" school:




Unhealthy, Unsafe, *Un*engaged, Unsupported, Challenged
