Teachers can use the “That’s Good! Now This” Frame to provide feedback to older students. Example 1 shows a form for teacher feedback only. Example 2 shows a form for monitoring student actions in response to feedback. The teacher completes the top half, and the student completes the bottom half and turns it in with the revised work.
