Thank you for your interest in this ASCD e-book. By choosing to download directly from ASCD, you get three formats of your e-book—PDF, Kindle-compatible MOBI, and EPUB—ensuring that you will be able to read your e-book on the device of your choosing. We understand that you may need to redownload this e-book if you change to a new computer or accidentally delete the files; you can do so within 90 days of your initial download.

Terms of Use

ASCD has opted to provide these e-book formats with minimal digital rights management. Only e-books downloaded from ASCD's website offer this ease and flexibility. Your download allows one person to retain an electronic copy of each e-book format for personal reading and to make one printout for personal use. Display on an intranet or website is prohibited. Troubleshooting

Devices and applications for e-reading vary in display and capabilities. If you experience challenges in viewing content, try adjusting the font size or other user-controlled settings on your device. Because the screen size of some e-reading devices is small, larger images, tables, and graphics may not display well, but they should view better in a desktop application (Adobe Acrobat Reader for PDF, Kindle for Mac or Kindle for PC for MOBI, Adobe Digital Editions for EPUB) or on a tablet. Which Format Is Right for You?

Because applications and devices display content differently, ASCD e-books are formatted to display best on the Kindle Keyboard, Kindle Touch, Kindle Fire, Nook Touch, Nook Tablet, and iPad (Kindle and iBooks applications). Use the Device and Recommended File Types chart to match the best format for your device; if your device or application is not listed, please refer to the device's website to learn which formats work best.

You may purchase and download an e-book directly to your e-reading device, or you may choose to download and retain an electronic copy of each e-book format on a personal computer, then transfer the compatible format to your device. Use the Formats and Recommended Loading chart for tips about opening your PDF, MOBI, and EPUB e-book files on your computer, tablet, or device. For more detailed instructions on how to load and read an e-book, please refer to the website for the device or application.

Formats and Recommended Loading

PDF	
<p>PDF e-books are most similar to the print book in layout and display. Although some devices have the capability to read PDF e-books, for optimal viewing, we recommend only the devices listed here.</p>	<p>Tablets</p> <p>Download the PDF e-book to your computer. Install Dropbox on your computer and your tablet and save the e-book in the app on your computer. Open Dropbox on your tablet and double-tap the e-book to select a reading app option (such as iBooks) to open the e-book. Note: you must already have your reading app installed on your tablet.</p>
	<p>Computer</p> <p>Download the PDF e-book to your computer and open it using Adobe Acrobat Reader.</p>
MOBI	
<p>The MOBI e-book format is for Kindle users. The format is reflowable, meaning the content will reflow to fit the display size of the application or device you are using. Reflowable formats allow you to make display choices such as font size and background lighting. In addition to the devices listed here, Amazon also offers Kindle apps for devices such as the iPad, the iPhone, or an Android tablet or device.</p>	<p>Tablets</p> <p>Download the MOBI e-book to your computer. Install Dropbox on your computer and your tablet and save the e-book in the Dropbox app on your computer. Open Dropbox on your tablet and double-tap the e-book to select a reading app option (such as the Kindle app) to open the e-book. Note: You must already have your reading app installed on your tablet. For Kindle Fire, follow the Dedicated Devices recommendation.</p>
	<p>Dedicated Devices (Kindle Keyboard, Kindle Touch)</p> <p>Download the MOBI e-book to your computer. Connect your device to your computer using a compatible USB cable, then copy the e-book from your computer into the desired folder on your device.</p>
	<p>Computer</p> <p>Download the MOBI e-book to your computer. Install a reader app, such as Kindle for PC or Kindle for Mac, and open the e-book in that app.</p>
EPUB	
<p>Like MOBI e-books, EPUB e-books are reflowable. You can read them on most dedicated e-reading devices, such as a Nook; on an iPhone, iPod Touch, iPad, Android tablet or device, or other mobile or multiplatform devices using a compatible app; or on your computer.</p>	<p>Tablets</p> <p>Download the EPUB e-book to your computer. Install Dropbox on your computer and your tablet and save the e-book in the Dropbox app on your computer. Open Dropbox on your tablet and double-tap the e-book to select a reading app option (such as iBooks) to open the e-book. Note: you must already have your reading app installed on your tablet.</p>
	<p>Dedicated Devices (Nook, Nook Touch, etc.)</p> <p>Download the EPUB e-book to your computer. Connect your device to your computer using a compatible USB cable, then copy the e-book from your computer into the desired folder on your device.</p>
	<p>Computer</p> <p>Download Adobe Digital Editions and open the e-book in that application.</p>
